Field Assistants Briefing (10:00 Meet in Gym)

1. Have your team sign in/check in (name, email and phone).
2. Thank them for coming to serve today!
3. If they are not on your sheet, that's OK. Just partner them with someone. Remember, we don't want to ever turn away a volunteer. Make them feel valued and welcome.
4. Remind them to serve with the love of Jesus (smiling, helping)
5. Tell them which age group they are assigned to.

6. PRAY! 😊
7. Go to kitchen to get all bags of stuffed chocolate eggs. BE CAREFUL! They pop open very easily. Eggs stuffed with milk chocolate have been in the freezer for the last 24 hours. Go to the Worship Center to get eggs stuffed with non-chocolate candy.
8. Bring eggs down to athletic field
9. Divide up the bags of eggs evenly for all age groups.
10. Make sure your area has a variety of candies. Each bag contains 300 eggs of one type of candy. Spread a little then take your bag and move to another area and spread some more.
11. Spread eggs on field starting at 10:50
12. As you spread eggs, make sure they are closed once they land in the grass.
13. Encourage kids to be courteous and careful
14. If your area has fewer kids than other areas, take bags of eggs over to really crowded age groups. Try and keep it as even as possible.
15. Replenish eggs as needed
16. If you have any late arrivals, direct them over to the Concordia Information table next to the Freddy's tables.
17. Look for someone with a radio or an elder with a nametag in case of emergencies or "situations".
